

ROLE OF THE PARENTS

Since Al Noor School only runs during the weekends, the progress of the student relies greatly on the regular practise and support from home. The school can provide assistance through study materials and site references on the school website.

Ibn 'Umar (May Allah be pleased with them) reported: The Messenger of Allah (PBUH) said: "The parable of one who knows the Qur'an by heart is as the parable of an owner of hobbled camel. If he remains vigilant, he will retain it; and if he neglects it, it will go away." [Al-Bukhari and Muslim].

Commentary: The person who memorizes the entire Qur'an or a portion of it, if he recites it regularly, he will retain it; otherwise, it will start slipping from his memory.

PARENTS/PEOPLE WILLING TO HELP AT SCHOOL

School encourages all to help at school as teacher/helper for its smooth functioning. There will be an interview with the Principal and will be required to fill in a staff application form.

FEES STRUCTURE

The school fees is £300 per child for an academic year (August until June). A registration fee of £45 is required at the time of registration. The upfront payment of annual fees will be appreciated.

The mode of payment is cash or cheque. Please observe and respect the upfront payment as it is important for managing the budget for the school.

For families with more than two children, the payment of fees will be that the fees for the 1st two children remains £300 per child and reduction of 20% to 3rd & more children. (For eg: Child 1 £300, Child 2 £300, Child 3 £240, Child 4 £240 and so on).

BRIEF HISTORY OF AL-NOOR ISLAMIC SCHOOL

The school has been run and assisted by a group of committed sisters and brothers thus providing a stable foundation of Islamic education for the children and is not in any way neither a profitable nor a commercial entity.

SCHOOL STRUCTURE & TIMING

The school runs during the weekends:

- Saturday: Islamic Studies
- Sunday: Quran Recitation Studies

The time period of a child in the school is from Grade 1 to Grade 10 for Islamic Studies taught via Goodword textbooks and IQRA Books(1 to 6) following the transition to recite Quran for QRS.

Class timing: 10.30am - 12.45pm

Age group: 5 to 15 years .

*Students may stay back for Jamaah prayer if parents are willing to assist their children.

ROLE OF THE SCHOOL

The aim of the school is to instil in the child the love for Qur'an and Sunnah.

This is implemented through a curriculum that includes a basic understanding and recitation of Quran with tajweed rules (progress depends upon the regular practise at home), knowing the Creator through His beautiful names, imaan, basic duties of a Muslim, and a basic knowledge on seerah, aqeedah, adaab, fiqh and hadith.

The teaching methodology involves learning through fun and colouring in younger grades and in higher grades through lectures and projects. The school follows an established syllabus, with committed teachers who keep continuous communication with the parents throughout the year.

Other activities include Eid party, Quran competition, and annual award ceremony.
